Introducing the R2i Speech, Language and Communication Needs (SLCN) Toolkit



Early identification

The R2i SLCN Toolkit helps schools identify needs early, enabling timely and targeted support. It aligns with the Access-Plan-Do-Review cycle and can guide referrals to Speech and Language therapy if needed.



Overview

The Toolkit includes whole-class approaches to boost language for everyone, plus SLCN screeners to guide more targeted support where needed.



Targetted areas of support

The early screeners help to put support in for individual children around key areas: Attention and Listening, Play, Social Communication, Understanding and Using Language and Speech.

With the R2i SLCN Toolkit, schools, families, your child and other professionals work as a team to understand communication needs and choose the best support.
