

Parking Outside Schools

The perennial issue of parking problems outside Schools is an ongoing subject for the Traffic & Safety service area. This problem may increase as businesses close their car parks to avoid the Workplace Parking Levy and staff park on the street to avoid any parking charges.

This is a constant source of complaint from citizens who voice their frustrations about the difficulties of congestion, safety, access and egress to their properties, caused by displacement or parents who pick up and drop off their children.

The Traffic & Safety service area incorporates Traffic Management and Road Safety who are there to help alleviate this issue by providing help, advice and support with the following concerns

- The Workplace Parking Levy & Parking Displacement
- School Travel Plans
- Parking Across a Dropped Crossing
- Parking on the Zig Zags
- Road Safety Education

There is not “one solution” to eradicate this problem as many measures are required to change the car culture.
